Dress:

- **Symphonic Band (1st and 2nd Block)**
 - Males - Symphonic Band will wear tux pants, white tux shirt, long black socks, marching shoes, red bow tie and white tux jacket
 - Females - will wear all black and black shoes
- **Wind Symphony (3rd Block)**
 - Males - Wind Symphony will wear tux pants, white tux shirt, long black socks, marching shoes, black bow tie and white tux jacket
- **Percussion**
 - You will dress according to which band you are performing with

8:00am - All students report to band room

- All Flutes, Clarinets, Alto Saxes, Trumpets and French Horns will take instruments on the bus with you
- All Tenor Saxes, Low Reeds, Euphonium, Trombone, Tubas and Percussion will have instruments loaded on trailer
- All male students will take their jackets on the bus in their garment bag

8:15am - Load buses and depart for Bainbridge

10:15am - Arrive at Southern Regional Technical College

10:30am - Symphonic Band goes to Warm-Up

- Leave cases on the bus
- Students with instruments on the trailer must quickly unload
- Wind Symphony will go in the audience and listen to Symphonic Band

11:00am - Symphonic Band Performance

- Once Symphonic Band is done performing they will exit the stage and listen to the Wind Symphony's Performance

11:30am - Wind Symphony to Warm-Up

12:00pm - Wind Symphony Performance

- As soon as Wind Symphony is done we will quickly load the trailer and buses
- We will provide you lunch at the buses for the drive home (Chick Fil A Sandwich, Chips and Drink). **YOU WILL NEED TO BRING \$5 AND GIVE TO THE CHAPERONE ON YOUR BUS**
