Based on past tournaments, there will be 40 to 45 teams, which will be divided into 5-6 flights. The teams will be pre-flighted based on the team's total handicap. Handicaps should not exceed 8 strokes between the two players forming a team. All handicaps need to be verified, and the max handicap allowed is 18. In the event a verified handicap is not presentable, a handicap committee reserves the right to adjust unverified handicaps in an attempt to prevent unethical play.

Entry Fee: \$450.00 per Team
Pre-Buy \$100.00 per Team
Includes golf and lunch both days, & a tee gift

All pre-buy money will go into one pot and a shootout will be held between the winners of each flight. The winning flight from the shootout will split the pot with each team in their flight that participated in the pre-buy. You must be present at the conclusion of the shootout to collect your winnings.

Important Tournament Information

- **Ringer Format Explanation-** The Valhalla Open is a two-day tournament. The first round (Friday) will be played like a regular two-man best ball tournament. The second round (Saturday) is where the ringer format will come into play. The ringer format is played where you can only tie or better your overall team score. Therefore, if your team’s best ball score on hole 1 Friday was a 4, and on Saturday your team’s best ball score is a 3. Then your overall team’s best ball score is a 3. If your team’s best ball score on Friday was a 4 and you make a 4 on Saturday, you will deduct a half a stroke to have an overall team best ball score of 3.5. However, if your team’s best ball score on Friday is a 4 and you make a 5 on Saturday, you will keep your 4 from Friday’s round as your overall team score. This means that each team will only have one 18-hole score after two rounds.

- **Shootout-** This year only the winner of each flight will play in the shootout. Therefore, we will have five or six two-man teams in the shootout. The shootout will be played out over the course of four holes. The format for the shootout will be a modified alternate shot. One team will be eliminated on each hole, or two on the first if there are six flights. If there is a tie, then a putt-off will determine who is eliminated. In order to participate in the shootout, your team’s pre-buy money (\$100) must be paid before the beginning of Friday’s round. The pre-buy money pot will be split between the winner of the shootout and the teams that paid into the pot of the winning flight. You must be present at the conclusion of the shootout to receive your money.
- **TIE-** If there is a tie for first in any flight or the shootout, the tiebreaker will be a putt-off.
